One Moon: Movements for the Human Wave of Connection

| Step 1 | Step 2 | Step 3 | Step 4 |

| Stand in a releaxed position with feet at hip width and arms loose by your side | Gently bend your knees and breathe in counting 1-2 (about 1 – 2 seconds like a steady heartbeat) | Gently straighten your knees and breathe out counting slowly 1-2 Repeat steps 2 and 3 x 4 | Reach your arms up as if reaching for the moon and look up |
| Step 5 | Step 6 | Step 7 | Step 8 |

| Slowly bring your arms down as if bringing the moon down from the sky – counting 4 | Imagine your are holding the moon in your hands in front of you | Slide your hands around the moon one way (counting 1-2) | Slide your hands around the moon the other way (counting 1-2). Repeat steps 4-8. |

You can then try steps 4-8 whilst walking.... Or add a twist to each side movement.... Or a little bounce as you reach up...

Design 2 Space Bracelet Level 2





You will need:

- White or silver pipe Cleaners
- Blue, silver or other space inspired coloured ribbons
- Silver sequin or other fabric of your choice

| Wrap a long strip of the sequin fabric around a pipe cleaner. Leave the extra length of fabric hanging. | The pipe cleaner will look like this when it's covered. | Bring the ends of the covered pipe cleaner together and twist to secure, to a size so that it fits over your hand and onto your wrist. | You will have created a ring with a hanging tail of fabric |

- Silver pipe cleaners
- Punched hole silver foil strip - head width.
- Ribbons blue and silver - cut longer than the foil strip.
